on the ~~principles~~ above mention principles to  
use and enjoy the whole of of the property as my  
wife and son William may think proper and  
I do hereby Declare this and no other to be my  
last will and testament, and I do hereby  
appoint my friend John Novwood Exe-  
cuter of the same October 14, 1813
