this my last will and testament. And as to such worldly
estate as it hath pleased God to intrust me with, I
dispose of the same as follows

First I direct that all my just debts be paid as soon
after my decease as possible, out of the first moneys
that shall come into the hands of my Executors,
from any portion of my estate real or personal.
I love the my beloved wife Abigail Boone my
plantation two horses, two cows, 4 calves, farming
utensils as much as my Executors may see
proper for her to have, two beds, and as much of
the house hold and kitchen furniture as my
Executors may see the need, during her natural
life or widowhood. I also love to my beloved wife
Abigail Boone four negroes (viz) woman Gilly, Jim,
Alford & Lou during her natural life or widowhood.
I love to my daughter in law Judith Boone negro
girl Eliza until my grand son Spencer Boone
arrives at the age of twenty one at which time
he can draw his part of the above stated negro
girl Eliza and her increase if she has any
also when my grand son Robert Pike Boone
arrives at the age of twenty one he can draw
his portion of negro girl Eliza and her increase
if she has any

Also when my grand daughter Charlotte
Boone arrives at the age of twenty one she
can draw her portion of negro girl Eliza and
her increase if she has any
I love the above stated negro girl Eliza to my
daughter in law Judith Boone until her three
children become of age provided she remains single

But if she survives before any grand children
of mine Boon, Robert Wm Boon and Elizabeth
Boon become of lawful age, I wish their
guardian to attend to it and place Eliza and
her increase if she has any to their advantage.
I will and bequeath to my beloved daughter
Leacy Boon, Mags and Eliza and after the decease
of my wife Abigail Boon more woman
child and son to their increase if there
be any, if my daughter Leacy Boon should
die without son heir I will this property
and their increase if there be any to my son
Barnet M. Boon with the exception of three
hundred dollars of it which I give to my
three grand children (viz) Grace Harmon, William
Robert Harmon, & Mary Barnet
Harmon. I give also to my daughter Leacy
Boon one bed and furniture.
I will and bequeath to my beloved son
Barnet M. Boon Carolina and her increase if
there should be any and after the decease
of my wife Abigail Boon more woman I give
to my daughter Elizabeth Sutton I have
given her as much of my estate as I intend.
I wish at the death of my wife Abigail
Boon for my daughter Leacy Boon if she
be remain on the plantation if she thinks
proper and in case of her death or marriage I
want the plantation and all the other property
with the exception of more woman child and her
increase if she has any and I wish that I have loaned
my wife Abigail Boon to be sold to pay my
debts and if there should be any thing left
after paying my debts and other expenses

I give it to my daughter Leacy Boon
And I do hereby make and ordain my beloved
son Barnet M. Boon and my utmost neighbor
Glover H. Plater Executors of this my last
will and testament.
