

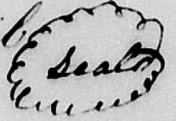
In the name of God. Amen. William Waddail

the same, — do make this my Last Will and
Testament in manner and form following. —

Item, I give and bequeath to my loving and

boy Abram; one bed, bedstead and furniture,
one desk, one Blue pine Chest during her
natural life, and at her death the same
to be disposed of as she may think proper.

Also thirty acres of Land, and my Chest of
working Tools together with every part and par-
cel of property of every description whatever that
I am possessed of during her natural life, and at
her death to be disposed of as above mentioned —

and I do hereby appoint John Wilson Executor
to this my Last Will and Testament, given under
my hand and seal this fourteenth day of
May 1832. —
