

The State of South Carolina,

I, Crown Torrence, of the County of Union, in the State aforesaid, being of sound mind and memory, do make, declare and publish this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking ant will and testament that may heretofore have been made and executed by me.

First.- I direct that all my just debts be paid from any personal property that I may own at the time of my death; and if such personal property be insufficient, then my Executrix is hereby authorized and directed to sell in such manner as she may deem most profitable and advantageous, either at public or private sale, so much of the real property of which I may be seized and possessed at the time of my death as may be deemed necessary to pay such said debts.

Second.- All the balance and residue of my property, both real and personal, of any kind and description whatsoever and wherever located, I give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Helen Sloan Torrence, absolutely and forever; my said wife to have absolutely all my personal property, and to have absolutely and in fee simple all the real property of which I am seized and possessed at the time of my death. Included in the aforesaid property hereby given, devised and bequeathed is all my undivided interest in and to all and singular the real and personal property of:-

(a) The estate of my Father, Dr. W.J. Torrence, deceased, late of

Torrence, deceased, late of Crowders Creek, in the State of North Carolina, said estate consisting, among other real and personal property, of two plantations of land, situate, lying and being near Crowders Creek, North Carolina, of which said lands the aforesaid Dr. W.J. Torrence died seized and possessed.

(b) The estate of my Uncle, J. Laban Falls, deceased, late of Gastonia, in the State of North Carolina, said estate consisting among other real and personal property, of the lot of land and building thereon, known as the "Falls House" hotel property, situate, lying and being in the city of Gastonia, in the State of North Carolina.

Third.- I nominate, constitute and appoint my beloved wife, Helen Sloan Torrence, of Union, in the State of South Carolina, the Executrix of this, my last will and testament; and it is my will and desire that she, as such Executrix, be required to give and furnish no bond.
