and publish this my last will and test-
ament in the name and form following
Vis 1st I direct that my executor under
the directions of my family at home shall
provide for my body a decent burial and
shall pay all of my funeral expenses and
all of my just debts however and to
whomsoever arriving out of the first
money that shall come into his hands.
2. A wife and bequeath to my daughter
Nancy E. Hines my home tract of land
lying on the west side of the public
road sixty five acres. I also will to my
daughter Nancy Estine lot no second
start at Sodom me line and run with
the old mill road to a wet weather branch.
thence North westerly to Luther Carpenter
line near a house all the land to the
rite of said line of lot no 2nd to the river
to my daughter Nancy E. Hines.

- lying on the west side of the publick
road sixty five acres. I also will to my
daughter Nancy Estlin lot No second
Start at Suttermeys line and run with
the old mill road to a wet weather branch.
thence North woods to Luther Carpenters
line near a house all the land to the
rite of said line of lot No 2 st to the river
to my daughter Nancy & Hines.
- 3 I will bequeath to my daughter Mary
A Rutledge all the land on the left of
lot No 2 second.
- 3 I will and bequeath to my son David
A Hines all the remaining lands on
the east side of the publick road which
is call lot No 1 st supposed to be seventy
Acres or to be equal divided between
D. A. Hines and Nancy & Hines.
- 4 I will and bequeath and devise to my
daughter Sarah, Adersholdt wife of
M. Adersholdt a tract of land in Cal-
well County in the State of North

Carolina witch track was conveyed
to me by deed from J. S. Balen & wife
witch deed is registered in Book C, page
444 & 445 in registrars office in said
Calhoun County and I also will and
bequeath to my said daughter wife of
James M. Adickholdt, the sum of fifty
dollars.

I do hereby give to such executor as the
Court shall appoint full power to
sell or compromise or otherwise act
and is in regard and reform to my
property just as if I was appointing
for myself.

was duly executed by said Daniel S.
Hines in the presence of said witnesses
and that at the time of signing the
same the said Daniel S. Hines was
of sound mind. It is thereupon
adjudged that the said paper writing
be admitted to probate as the last
will and testament of the said
Daniel S. Hines.

Orphanage, established at Barren
Springs in said State, the sum of One
Thousand Dollars (\$1000), to be expended
for the benefit of said Orphanage as the
Regents may think best;
I give, devise and bequeath all the resi-
due of my estate, real and personal,
to my dear sister Julia C. Worcester,
of Asheville, North Carolina, to have,
and use the same for her own benefit,
as long as she lives, with full power
and authority to sell any of my real
estate as she thinks most advisable, and
to change investments as she chooses,
and upon her death said property shall
be equally divided among her children
that survive her, provided, however, that
she may by Will direct what portion of
said estate each of said children shall
have, and she may also direct that the
share of any one or more of said children
shall be vested in a Trustee or Trustees,
with the provision for the payments

to each child of only the income from his
 of her share and with the provision that
 in the event each child shall die leaving no
 issue, ^{his or her share shall then be divided among the surviving children} I trust this matter entirely to her good
 judgment:
