

Be it remembered that I Hannah Henkle of the County of Gaston & State of North Carolina being of sound mind & memory do make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say) first I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Osburn Henkle the tract of land that I lately lived on containing eighty five Acres, 2^d I likewise give unto him the said Osburn Henkle one Bed and furniture said Bed striped with blue, also one extra quilt and brown Turpin. 3^d I give unto my son William Henkle one Bed and furniture. 4th I will unto my grand son Willis Underwood fifty cents, 5th I will unto my Osburn Henkle my Chest and Table with all my personal goods & chattels of every description not willed above, 6th I further hereby make and appoint my son Osburn Henkle sole Executor of this my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 29th day of September the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & sixty five
