I direct that my Executors a portion off to my
daughter Elvira Bell one year support of Provisions
and corn and proceadure for her mule and cow and
the remainder of my crop be sold to pay my debts &c.
I direct that the remainder of my Live stock be
sold to pay my Last Expenses and debts
and Lastly I desire that my son Miner Bell
Execute this my Last Will and Testament by me
made Revoking all others by me made by me

the remainder of my crop be sold to pay my debts
I direct that the remainder of my live stock be
sold to pay my last Expenses and debts
and Lastly I desire that my son Miner Bell
