I, Julia A. Harrison of said County and State, being of sound mind and body, do hereby declare this to be my last will and testament, that is to say:

Item 1. That after giving my body a decent burial in keeping with my station in life, and after paying my just debts I give, bequeath and devise all my property, both real and personal, the said real property now consisting of a tract of land in said county upon which I now reside, and known as a part of the Max Stroup place, and all the real and personal property which I may hereafter acquire to my step son, John W. Harrison in trust, and for the use and benefit of my step children, Mary Miller Harrison and Robert Lee Harrison with full power and authority in the said trustee to use so much of said personal property or the rents, income or profits of said lands for the support sustenance and comfort of the said Mary Miller Harrison, or Robert Lee Harrison as in the judgment of the said trustee may be necessary and proper, the said personal property and income and rents from said lands to be given and used for the said Mary Miller and Robt. Lee Harrison in equal shares and portions share and share alike in same.

Item 2. I will, devise and bequeath that the said trustee shall hold

the said Mary Miller and Robt. Lee Harrison in equal shares and portions share and share alike in same.

Item 2. I will, devise and bequeath that the said trustee shall hold said property as aforesaid for each of said step children cestui que trust until he or she becomes of age when the one so coming of age as aforesaid shall receive and have a fee simple and full right and title to said personal property and real estate in equal parts, share and share alike.

Item 3. I designate the said John W. Harrison my lawful Executor, but will that he receive no commissions or other compensation, either for acting in the capacity as trustee as aforesaid, or in the capacity of Executor, as aforesaid.
