dollars in cash to her and her heirs forever.

3rd To my said Sister Elizabeth G. Williard and Louisa M. Garrett.
and to my brother Joseph J. Garrett, I give devise and bequeath
in equal shares that is. One third to Elizabeth G. Williard.
One-third to Louisa M. Garrett. and One third to Joseph J. Garrett.
All my Estate and property real and personal that remains
after the above mentioned two special legacies have been paid,
to them and their heirs forever.

I Appoint Dr. S. P. Williard of Rocky Mount, N.C. Executor
Without bonds, of this my Will.
