VII. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife the remainder of my property, both personal and real of whatever it may consist.

VIII. I will and desire that the shares of my daughter Pauline and my son Yates be invested or placed on interest and the interest used for their maintenance and education until they become of age.

IX. I will and devise that my Executrix sell so much of my real property as may be necessary at any time she considers best, in order to procure the amounts heretofore I willed to Carrie, Lee and Edna Lentz.

X. And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Katie Lentz my lawful executrix to all intents and purposes to execute this my last Will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause thereof, hereby revoking and declaring utterly void All other wills and testaments by me heretofore made.
