I Will and bequeath to my good & faithful friend Richard Hart all my property of every description which I own consisting of 27 $\frac{1}{2}$  Acres of land on which I now live, Household & Kitchen furniture, Beds, Bedsteads & Bed Coverings, Bureau, Tables, Chairs & all other things, Fowls & Pigs & Growing Crops. Provided he build a house for himself on this place & maintain and take care of me the balance of my life, (this includes boarding, Clothing & Attention in sickness,) And lastly I appoint Mr W<sup>l</sup> Howell my Executor.
