I, Thomas William Greenwell of Broomshields in the County of Durham, hereby declare this to be my last will and testament. I appoint my brothers Herbert Maitland Greenwell of Maunton House Pershore in the County of Worcester and Leonard Bridges Greenwell of 290 Hanworth Road Hounslow in the county of Middlesex (hereinafter called my trustees) to be the Executors and Trustees of this my will and guardians of my infant son Thomas William Maddison Greenwell. I bequeath to the said Herbert Maitland Greenwell and Leonard Bridges Greenwell the sum of five hundred pounds each free of legacy duty. I give, devise and bequeath to my Trustees all the residue of my real and personal estate of whatsoever kind and where-soever situate upon trust for my said son upon his attaining the age of twenty one years, and I direct that my trustees shall have power in their uncontrolled discretion to sell my property in America, and I direct that my trustees shall have full power to manage my estate and for that purpose to grant leases thereof for such terms and at such rents as they shall

my trustees shall have full power to manage my estate and for that purpose to grant leases thereof for such terms and at such rents as they shall think fit, and I direct that my trustees shall be entitled to charge my estate for all expenses which they may incur in connection with the management of my estate.
