To all &c Wheresoever now knowe you that I the said Edward Howard Governor & Co. doe with ye Consent of ye Councill of State accordingly give and grant unto Mr. Edward Billton and Mr. William Leigh fiftie hundred acres of land, situate
lying and being in Newhant County, on y^e North side of Rattanay River, upon a maine Branch of proceedeth out off aforesaid River known by y^e name of Oppanumyscoke branch, beginning at a marked white Oak, standing on y^e Western side of y^e said Branch by or near of S^d day thereof, and running downe y^e side of y^e said Branch two hundred and fifty ro. being its breadth, & its length bounded with a tract of land supposed to be surveyed by George Chapman and so by opposite fourroes, and angles to place it began, with the land being formerly granted to John Collett by patent bearing date of tenth day of Febrary 1668, after whose death one John Willmell who married of Widow of y^e said Collett debated of the land in y^e year 1670, Willmell was an Alien, and afterwards Mr. Phillip Walmsley purchased of y^e Willmell, & right long since by Virtue whereof, as also by virtue of an Order of y^e Compt^r, and paid y^e said Phillip Walmsley, of Elizabeth his wife by their Deed of Bargaine & Sale bearing date of March 1675. sold y^e said land to y^e said Thomas Scawle, and also acknowledged y^e said land in Newhant County Court of 28th of January 1675. as may appear, wch y^e said land was deputed by y^e said Willmell for want of due holding according to Law, and now granted by virtue of y^e said Court by y^e said Mr. Edward Billton and Mr. Wm Leigh bearing date of 22nd day of October 1684, & further due by and for transportation of ten persons into this Colony, whose names are in y^e Books mentioned under this patent. To have and to hold £5 To be held & expediting & paying £⁰ provided by y^e said Court of 25th of October 1684.

To all &c Wheresoever now knowe you that I the said Edward Howard Governor & Co. doe with ye Consent of ye Councill of State give & grant unto Eafon Moore fifty acre of Land lying in or y^e Cypress Swamp in Lyngham parish in y^e County of Lower Norfolk bounding on adiuert of land formerly & Edm^t Reets called bear quarter, Beginning at a tree running into y^e Cypress Swamp & running West Ninety pr. on y^e old time of eight trees to a poplar & a bush, then north by west on y^e old eight trees one hundred & five p. to an ash by a tree, then west by south forty p. to y^e Cypress Swamp, by same bounding downe the said swamp to y^e first mentioned run up y^e said run to y^e first station & is due by and for transportation of one person into this Colony & To have & to hold the same. To be held & expediting & paying £⁰ provided by y^e said Court of 21st of October 1684.
