To all whomeas it now knowe that I y^e Francis
Lord Howard Govern^r do with y^e consent of y^e Council
of State accordingly give and grant unto Mr. Edward
Chilton and Mr. William Leigh fiftie hundred acres of land, situate
lying and being in Henric County, on y^e north side of Watkinson
River, upon a maine Branch y^e proceedeth out of y^e aforesaid River
known by y^e name of Appanamycoke Branch, beginning at a
marked white labe, standing on y^e Western side of y^e Branch
by or near y^e labe thereof, and running down y^e Branch
two hundred and fifty p^o. being its breadth, & its length bounded
with a tract of land supposed to be surveyed by George Chapman
and so by opposite four p^o. and angle to y^e place it began, with
y^e land being formerly granted to John Rolfe by patent bearing
date y^e tenth day of May 1668, after whose death our John Rolfe
who married y^e Widdow of y^e aforesaid Rolfe y^e land in y^e y^e Rolfe
was an Alien, and afterwards our Phillip Watkinson purchased y^e
y^e Rolfe's share Right by y^e Rolfe's will, as also by virtue of
an order of y^e Court, and finally y^e Phillip Watkinson, & Elizabeth
his Wife by their deed of bargain & sale bearing date y^e tenth
of Jan^y 1675. sold y^e land to y^e Thomas Sawell, and also
acknowledged y^e said in Henric County Court y^e 28th of January
1675. as may appear, with y^e land was forfeited by y^e Sawell
for want of due fealty according to Law and now granted by order
of y^e Court to y^e Mr. Edward Chilton and Mr. Wm Leigh bearing
date y^e 22th day of October 1684, & further due by and for y^e transportation
of ten persons into this Colony, whose names are in y^e Record mentioned under

line of white line to a poplar & a birch, then north by West
on y^e old white line one hundred & six p^o. to an ash by a run
side, then West by South forty p^o. to y^e Cypress Swamp, & then
bounding down y^e said Swamp to y^e first mentioned run
to y^e said run to y^e first station & is due by and for y^e trans-
