with the advice and consent of the Council of State accordingly give and grant unto  
William Wifford power full and sole authority that he should and lawfully should  
make a dyke or dykes running westward out of the North River in the County of Lower  
Norfolk beginning at a place called standing by the Cyprus Swamp and bounding on  
the Swamp first North North East fifty paces poles then North easterly poles to  
a white stake in the said Swamp East in the said Swamp and bounding of the Creek  
thence East by South easterly eight poles to a Boon then North East by North  
easterly two poles to a Elm tree then East bounding on the border of the Creek easterly  
power poles to a market Boon then South South East easterly six poles to a white stake  
on the border of the North River then on that person South South West fifty two  
poles to a great poplar then North East by East easterly two poles in the said  
border to a market white stake then East South East easterly poles in the border to  
a red stake then South by West easterly poles to a pine then South West by market  
West by market trees twenty poles to a red stake in a border then North  
easterly eight poles to a red stake then North West two hundred and eighty  
poles by market trees to a Elm standing on the great Cyprus Swamp then bounding  
on the said Swamp according to its border all courses to the first mentioned Elm the said  
land being due by and for the transportation of Wyndyons and this holding whole name  
was under this patent to have and to hold of the said Lord Howard and his heirs  
the twentyeth day of April 1686

the South and North by two parallel lines running South East by East two  
hundred easterly eight poles from Robert Johnson his two corner trees the said  
land being formerly granted unto German Dill by patent dated the ninth of November  
then Charles and six hundred sixty six and by him forfeited and is now granted unto the  
said William Rendall by order of the General Court held at James City  
the fifteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred  
eighty five which said land is due unto him by and for the transportation of Wyndyons  
into this Colony whose names are under this patent to have and to hold of the said Lord  
Howard and his heirs the 20th of April 1686

a corner tree of William Edwards and running East South East by market trees  
three hundred poles to a great white stake by the said Run then South South West  
sixty six poles to a Boon then South East easterly eight poles to a Elm  
then North West by South by market trees sixty poles to a Elm by the Reddy Branch  
then bounding on the North West side of the Reddy Branch according to the  
border all courses to the great Cyprus Swamp then bounding on the said  
Cyprus Swamp making up the mouth of the Reddy Branch to the said  
market Boon which said land is due unto him by and for the transportation of Wyndyons  
into this Colony whose names are under this patent to have and to hold of the said Lord  
Howard and his heirs the 20th of April 1686
