of Advice and Consent of the Council of State accordingly five and Brant unto
Nicholas Turpin a tract of land containing two hundred and fifteen acres
lying and being in the County of Henrico, also in the parish of Virginia, bounded
by the North side of James River, first beginning at a corner white oak standing
on the line of Thomas Taylor, and Runnely River along Taylors line North
west one hundred twenty eight poles to two corner trees standing on the
maine branch of Riddabone in of fort, thence up that Branch North West
East twenty poles, and North thirty poles to a corner tree, thence North East
and by North one hundred fifty two poles to a corner Cockshuey, thence
East forty eight poles to a corner River, thence South sixty poles to a corner
black oak, thence East by North fifteen poles to a corner tree, thence South
East and by South twenty two poles to the line of Nicholas Perkins
thence along Perkins his line South one hundred fifty two poles to a corner
black oak, thence South West forty six poles to a corner white oak, thence
West fifty two poles to place he began, including of aforesaid two
hundred & fifteen acres of land, and due by him for transportation of
five persons into this Colony, whose names are in the Records mentioned

unto Thomas Jeff. Three hundred acres of land lying in Woods towards the
North River landing upon a Cypress Swamp in the parish of Synkewon, also in
Lower Norfolk County, beginning at a maple standing by the swamp, a
corner tree of morgan woods, and running on his marsh trees, three
hundred and twenty poles East North East, then against from the said
maple, and bounding on the swamp South South East one hundred
and fifty poles to a white oak by the swamp side, thence East North
East of marsh trees eighty two poles to an Ash, then continuing
by the course East North East two hundred thirty eight poles, thence
North North West one hundred and fifty poles to the end of the line
East North East line. The said land being due of him for transportation
of five persons into this Colony whose names are in the Records men-
tioned under this Patent. To have and to hold Cr. for 63 years & yielding
& paying Cr. Provided Cr. dated this 20th day of April Anno Domini 1684.
