 Esq^r Governor of Virginia and Grant unto and Henry Woodhouse four hundred acres
 of land and Swamp lying in Lynhaven parish at the time of the Survey on
 the County of Lower Norfolk but now Pinion Run County beginning at a pine on
 his old home called the quarter and running South eight and four pole to a gum
 then west north west thirty three pole to a pine then South by west eighty
 two pole to a white oake then South East fifty four pole to a maple then
 South of West one hundred fifty one pole to a pine then west by north
 twenty pole to a maple then South South west half westerly fifty two pole
 to a white oake then againe from the beginning pine and running South East
 one hundred and one pole to a water lake in the maine Swamp then South
 East of South half a point and better Southerly ninety six pole to Jacobson's
 Pine then South Seventy eight pole to a holly then East South East forty
 two pole to a gum called Jones tree nearest bounding on Salls land to the
 head of Spratt and thence to William Capps head land to a pine and from
