Tho. Brock Deed of
Gift to his Children.

To all to whom these pèsents shall come I, Thomas Brock of Linhaven in Princess Anne County send greeting &c. Know ye that I the sd Thomas Brock for & in consideracon of the Natural love & affection that I doe beare unto my three sons, namely John Brock James Brock & Samuëll Brock & for their future good & maintenance, have & doe by these pèsents fully & freely by this my absolute deed of gift, give, grant, and forever confirme unto my said three sons these several tracts, psells or dividents of land following (Viz.) I doe hereby give, grant, & absolutely confirme unto my aforesd son John Brock ninety acres of land bounding easterly upon the pòsson of the fresh ponds & Northerly upon the Rudee Swamp and westerly upon the plantacon I now live upon, to him & to his heires of his body lawfully begotten forever, and unto my son James Brock I doe give grant & confirme ninety acres of land lying and being upon the uppermost end of my land upon long ridge, unto him and to the heires of his own body lawfully begotten: and unto my other abovesd son Samuëll Brock I give, grant & confirme ninety acres of land lying and being upon brushie ridge unto him and to the heires of his body lawfully begotten: To Have & To Hold the abovesd severall pecells or tracts of land as abovemenconed bounded & specified unto them my said sons & to each and every of them as abovesd and to every of the heires as above-menconed forever free and clear of & from all manner of lawfull claime, right, title, interest, challenge or demand wtsoever of me the said Thomas Brock my heires Exes. or Admes. or any other psons wtsoever from by or under my, my means or procurement and that they & every of them be actually possessed of the said land as above given to every one of them, and enjoy

the same with all the priviledges & appurtenances to the same belonging immediately after they
& every of them shall attain to the age of eighteen years: In Witness whereof I have hereunto

Will and Testamt.

In the name of God Amen, I, William Robinson of Elizabeth river in the County of Norfolk in
Virga.. being at present reasonable well in body thanks be to almighty God for it, yet well
knowing that man was born to die but the time uncertain doe therefore & at this time make this
my last will & testamt. in manner & forme following, revoking all former will or wills by me
made & this to be taken & deemed as my last will & testamt. 1st I bequeath my body to the
earth from whence it come and my soul to committ to God my through the merrits of my only
Saviour Jesus Christ to enter it that & love purchased by his most pretions blood for all true
& penitent believers; And for my worldly goods that God in merry hath been pleased to lend me
I give & bequeath as followeth: 2ly I give and bequeath unto my well beloved son Tully Ro-
binson the land or plantacon I now live upon with all the land of mine adjoining unto it
with all housing orchards &c., during his life & after his death to my well beloved grand son
& his son William Robinson and to his heires for-ever: 3ly: I give unto my well beloved grand
son Wm. Robinson two hundred acres of land being parte of 350 acres comonly known by the name
of Peters Ridge I say to him and his heires for-ever; 4ly: I give unto my well beloved grand-
son Wm. Smith one hundred and fifty acres of land, the remainder of the abovesaid land known
by the name of Peters Ridge I say to him & his heires forever; 5ly I give unto my well
beloved son Tully Robinson two negro men the one named Jack, the other named Mingo, I say to
him and his heires forever; 6ly I give unto my well beloved daughter Elizabeth Smith two
negroes one man named Will & one girl named Betty I say unto her & her heires forever, but my
will is that if the sd negro girle lives to have children, then my will is that they the sd
children be disposed of as my sd daughter thinks fitt, but amongst her children by her now hus
band Mr. George Smith; 7ly I give unto my well beloved daughter Mary Throwgood two negroes one
one man named Craford and one woman named Moll & after her death to her heires forever; 8ly
