unto my son ^{William} Blanchard his heirs and assigns for ever all the Land on
the other side of the Road and all the Land other side of the Pond Branch.
Item I give and Bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Blanchard her
heirs over floor and Chamber and all my House hold furniture and
all my Black Horses Cattle Hogs and Sheeps Likewise as long as she
lives a widow and if she marries or at her Death then all my movable
Estate shall be given Dividing between my four Children Frederick
William Sarah and Mary and my Deare Wife Equal Child share
with them all and giving to my Born Child and Sarah if she
marries. I do hereby appoint my wife Mary Blanchard and
John Smith my sole Executors of this my Last Will and Testament.
Witness my hand and seal the same fully executed and performed in the
presence of John Smith.

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I am now in the shadow of North Carolina and being weak
in body but of a sound mind and thanks to God for the same I do make
this my last Will and Testament as followeth I give and
bequeath unto my Son Frederick Blanchard his heirs and assigns
for ever my Plantation and all the Land this side of the Road and
all the Land this side of the Ponts Brance Item I give and bequeath
unto my Son ^{William} Blanchard his heirs and assigns for ever all the Land on
the other side of the Road and all the Land other side of the Conabronne.
Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Blanchard
Wife now of me and her heirs and all my Household furniture and
all my Stock Horses Cattle Pigs and Sheeps like unto as long as she
lives a widow and if she marries or at her Death then all my moveable
Estate shall be equal Dividing between my fore children Frederick
William Jacob and Mary and my Dear Wife Equal Child share
with them all and giving to my Dear Widow and Sidel if she
marries her bond and offring my wife Mary Blanchard and
Mary to be my sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament
Reading thereof in the same fully debated and performed in Witness
whereof I the said Frederick Blanchard have hereunto set my hand
and affixed the seal of my Office the 10th day of December in the year 1800
