the uncertainty of this mortal life do make and ordain this to be my last
Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say I give
Item I leave to my Loving wife Letitia Boston the use of that part of
my Land and Plantation that lies between the main Road and the Creek
to Job Waddicks here being part of Saw Plantation During her life I also
give to my said wife a Negro man called Yellow Jack to her and her heirs
and assigns for ever I also give to my said wife four Cows & calves and five
Cubs and Lambs and a Small Horn called Munking also one feather Bed
and furniture and five Sows and pigs Six beans one basket and one
also one kind part of my Testament and one third part of my Stock to my
said wife Letitia I give to my Son James Boston the Other third part

I Bought of Edmund Tupper I give to my Son James Boston the Plantation
now on Snow hill and when he arrives to the age of Twenty one my will
that the Land belonging to the two said Plantations be Divided so that each
Plantation have an equal Number of acres I say to my Son Isaac and
James and to their Heirs and assigns for ever I give to my Son Thomas
Boston four Thousand & Fifty eight acres of Land new entered Survey
and Abund I say to him his Heirs and assigns for ever Item I give to
my Son Nathaniel Boston all my Land lying in the wild Pelasmy to
him his Heirs and assigns for ever Item I give to my Daughter Sister
Boston one Negro man named Jack 1 Bed and Furniture two cows & calves
to her her Heirs and assigns Item I give to my Daughter Sarah Boston one
Negro man called Gabriel to her and her Heirs and assigns also one
Feather bed and Furniture Two cows & calves I give to my Daughter
Leah Boston one Negro man called Reuben one Feather bed and Furniture
Two cows & calves two Cows and Lambs 1 Saddle and Gear and Six Sup
plies to her and her Heirs and assigns Item I give to my Son Thomas
Boston and my Son Nathaniel Boston and my Son Benjamin Boston
and my Daughter Elizabeth Boston and my Daughter Poley Boston
four Negro namely Panner Willm. L. L. L. L.

four Negroes namely Fanner Mills Sam & Amey my will is that when
my son Thomas comes to the age of twenty one the said four Negroes be
Equally Divided between my foresaid three Sons & Two Daughters I say
to them their Heirs and assigns I give all the Rest and Residue of my
Estate not all Ready given to be Equally Divided between my five
Youngest Children Thomas Nathaniel Benjamin & Elizabeth Polly
Heirs to them their Heirs and assigns Lastly I nominate and appoint
my Brother James Boston and my friend David Kier Executors of this my
Last will and Testament to see the same performed according to my true
Intent and meaning in Writings whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and put my seal this Twelfth day of August 1782 Danvers Co. Vermont
