and my father his Indentured Servant I nominate and appoint my
said Wife Elizabeth Watters to be Executor to this my Last will and Testament
and my father when I shall be so move to honestly and true fulfill
all the said Particulars above mentioned according to my Intent and
purpose in this behalf I wish I nominate and make with all former Will
and Testament for made the Watters whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and my seal this Twelfth day of February one Thousand Seven Hundred
and Sixty Seven James Bragg Watters

boy named Bobb that I give to my Father my wife Elizabeth Walters
and my Father and my Mother and my Father and my Mother and my
Father and my Mother to be Executors of this my Last will and Testament
And when I shall be no more to remain in and truly fully all
the said Particulars above mentioned according to my Intent and
purpose I do hereby Publish my will and Testament and I have hereunto set my hand
at the City of New York the Twenty first of February one thousand six hundred
and twenty three years
