August County Court of Pleas & 1793

Last Will and Testament of Sarah Lapsiter dec'd, was exhibited into Court by Isaac Hunter & James Boston Executors therein appointed and was proved by the Oaths of Isaac Boston one of the subscribing Witnesses and on motion was ordered to be recorded as the same being the said Exec's Came into Court and qualified themselves for that office &c.

In the name of God Amen Joel Goodman of Gates County in the State of North Carolina am at this time weak of body but of perfect mind and memory do think proper and fit to make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following
It is my desire to be buried in a Christian manner at the discretion of my executor. Item It is my desire that all my just debts and charges should be discharged in due time. Item I give and bequeath unto my brother William Goodman all my land and plantation whereon I now live with all the improvements thereon

John Goodman and his heirs forever also my horse still and one my
ward of honor and my horse piddle and saddle and half
part of all kind of tools and his heirs forever also my kitchen
furniture metal or kind whatsoever to him and his heirs forever
And give and bequeath unto my brother Cyprian Goodman one my
gold named Nancy to him and his heirs forever also half
of my stock of all kinds

And give and bequeath to my sister Mary Goodman one my
Roman named Lucy and one boy named Abram to her
and her heirs forever

And give and bequeath to my brother William Goodman all the
money that my brother Henry Goodman is due me and my
brother John Goodman to pay the balance that I am due to
James Goodman and all the court charges.

And give and bequeath all the money that the estate of John Goodman Dec'd is
due me to my brother Cyprian Goodman to him ^{and his} heirs forever

And I nominate and appoint my brother Cyprian Goodman
and my brother William Goodman my sole and sole exe-
cutors to this my last will and testament. Disannulling and
making void all other wills by me made or cause to be made
as witness my hand and seal this fourth day of May one thousand
and seven hundred and ninety five
