Sarah Davis during her life or widowhood likewise leave her
the use of all my household furniture and after her death or
marriage I give to my loving daughter Ruth Davis one bed
and furniture one iron pot to her and her heirs forever.
I give and bequeath to my loving daughter Asenath Davis one
bed and furniture one iron pot and all my furniture to equally
divided between my two daughters Ruth and Sarah Davis
to them and their heirs forever. I give and bequeath to my be-
loved son David Davis after the death or marriage of my wife
Sarah Davis the plantation whereon I now live and all
the lands thereunto belonging and all my Copers tools one
iron pot one great coat and one sheep skin

them and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved son John Davis five shillings sterling to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to loving daughter Judith Pears five shillings sterling to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving daughter Priscilla Griffin five shillings sterling to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving son Abner Davis one bed and furniture one iron pot and some further articles that he has already had to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving daughter Sarah Lakin five shillings to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving daughter Rachel Miller five shillings to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving daughter Minam Phelps five shillings to her and her heirs forever.
