and one plate to her and her heirs for ever I give to my Grandson
Ezekiel Rofs one Sealring one silver plate Plate to him and his heirs
for ever I give to ~~my~~ Solomon Rofs all my Land to him and his
heirs for ever I Give to my wife Barthaney Rofs the use of my house
and Lands and household goods and chattels of what nature or kind
soever During her natural life or widowhood and after her Death
I give them all to my Son Solomon Rofs my will and Desire is that
if my Son Solomon dies without Heir that my Grandson Ezekiel Rofs
should have the Land I give to my Daughter Sarah ^{two} Shillings I give to my Daughter Mary ^{two} Shillings and
Sixty Pence and appoint my Loving Wife and my Son
John Thomas Rofs Executors of this my Last Will and Testament
in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and

I give to my Son Solomon Toss all my Land to him and his
Heirs for ever I Give to my wife Bethaney Toss the use of my house
and Land and house hold goods and Chattels of what nature or kind
soever During her natural life or widowhood and after her Death
I give them all to my Son Solomon Toss my will and Desire is that
if my Son Solomon dies without Heir that my Grandson Ezekiel Toss
should have the Land I give to my Daughter Sarah
Shillings I give to my Daughter Mary Toss two Shillings and
Sixpence I do hereby Appoint my Loving Wife and my Son
John Thomas Toss Executors of this my last Will and Testament
in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and the Seal of

Lasting Testamentary Affairs I do hereby declare that I am of sound mind and memory

and State of North Carolina being sick & weak in health but of a perfect
mind & memory do hereby make Constitutions and ordains this to be my Last will and
Testament in manner & form following (that is to say, First & principally I commend
my soul to God that gave it Hoping that through the Merits of my Dear
Redeemer Jesus Christ to receive a full and free Pardon for all my sins when I
leave this world and for Inventing Disputes hereafter I do give and Devise of my
worldly Estate in the following manner Viz. First I give and Devise unto my Son
John Benton the Sum of Five Shillings specie to him & to his use Secondly I give
and Devise unto my Grandson John Benton the Sum of Five Shillings specie to
him & to his use Thirdly I give and Devise unto my Grandson John Benton
the Sum of Five Shillings specie to him & to his use Fourthly I give and Devise
unto my Daughter Mary Benton one feather bed & furniture to her & to her proper
use Fifthly I give and Devise unto my Daughter Martha Benton one feather
bed & furniture to her & to her proper use Sixthly I give & Devise unto my Son
Jeremiah Benton my Black Coll Colled Horse & Saddle & Bridle & Harness
