trunk scum of axes & forks & braver & theater scum & side round
saddle & horn and a stage & harnesses two tubs & scales & some iron
chairs all my geese & poultry all my flax cotton and flax for
bush two chest two tables all the Croquet & hand tools
a piece of Iron wire & some more

hand two chest two tables all the household & household things
a pair of Iron wags & harnesses two pair of calfs

I give both stubble & three coat and such and all my
corn and meath to she and care for ever to dispose with as he
se fitz and give all my cloth to be divided between my loving wife
and my loving mother-in-law

Item Give to my loving mother now and for ever a shute.

Item Give unto George White my brother Joshua White and all the lands
and and premises there unto belonging that he bore of Henry
Hill lying in Gates County to him and his eazs forever and the
rest of my estate to be equally divid between my three brothers
Thomas White George White & Joshua White to them and their
eazs forever. Likewise constitute this to be my last will
and Testament all and singular Revolving all others and I
likewise appoint my brother Joshua White and my loving wife
Elizabeth White to be my sole exectors as proving by some one
this to be my last will and Testament in witness where of
I have set my hand and seal this ninth day of March in the
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two
