Moore share and share alike. —

And I nominate and appoint Starkey Sharp Esq and Joseph
Radick my sole executors desiring them to see this my last
will and testament fully executed according to the true
intent and meaning thereof In witness whereof I the said
Rachel Fortman the testator have hereunto set my
hand and fixed my seal this tenth day of January 1791
