Will and Testament in manner and form following viz. First I give

the Discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned and as for my worldly
Estate which it hath Pleased God to bestow upon me I give and dispose
of as followeth viz. First I give unto my Loving Wife Mary Hayball
my Personal and Real Estate during her Natural life or widowhood after
which I shall bestow of it in the following manner viz. Item I give
and Bequeath unto my Son James Hayes the Plantation whereon I now
Dwell and also a Mill that is there upon on condition that he will let
his Brothers settle their own Lives without any Tole and also one pair of
iron scales and one Flax Hackle on condition that he lets his Brothers
and Sisters make use of the same to hackle their own Flax Item I give
and Bequeath all the Land that I have joining unto my Son James Hayes
line unto my Son Wright Hayes and also one lease of bottles and one Church
Bible to him and his heirs forever, Item I give and bequeath unto my
Son Daniel Hayes and his three Sisters Sarah, Dorcas and Mary Hayes
all my lands in Giles County

his Brothers still their own Livers without any Tole And also one pair of
iron scales and one Flax Hackle on Condition that he lets his Brothers
and Sisters make use of the same to hackle their own Flax Item I give
and Bequeath all the Land that I have joyning unto my Son James Hayes
line unto my Son Wright Hayes And also one lease of bottles and one Church
Bible to him and his heirs forever, Item I give and bequeath unto my
Son Daniel Hayes and his three Sisters Sarah, Darcas and Abby Hayes
all my land and Tenter to be equally Divided among them and there
of Item I give and Bequeath unto my Son Jacob Hayes one set
of Weaves with what I have already and whatsoever else of my Estate
which I have not already Disposed of my Will is that it be Equally
Divided among all my Children to Wives Lawful heirs &c
I also leave my two Sons James Hayes and Wright Hayes my Executors
to carry out this and Testimony as Witness whereof I have set my
hand and given seal William Hayes
Witness my hand this 20th day of North Carolina Hatter County 17th August Superior
Court of the said County 1798 The within Will was
read and heard by James Hayes and Wright Hayes Executors

 of the same title the said Consistory came into Court and qualified him
 for that office and prayed an order for Letters Testimonialis from which
 was accordingly granted.
