a second husband she shall have equall part as with
the rest of the children being in life at the time of
the marriage I choose and appoin Jacob Waddall and
Sherat Kerns and my wife as exccelors to sell and
make morny of my estate and that the same be divided
in equall parts among my wife and children and if
she remain in widowhood she shall have ^{right} to manage
my estate as sole tuler and excecutor the time of her
life Signed and Sealed
