Give unto my Daughter Giovanneth Basket one Pistole I
Likewise Desire that all my Goods and Chattles after my
Wife Phebe McMillion Shall Live this Life may be
Equally Divided amongst all my younger Children
And I make and ordain my two Sons Mattheu and
James McMillion Executors of this my Last Will and Testament
