her Life and after her Death my Will is that my

have all my Land where on I now dwell

Item and my negro fellow named Frank I Give to my Son
Arthur Jordan after the Death of my wife
and my negro boy Ben I Give to my Daughter Elizabeth
William to her and her heirs for ever after the
Death of my wife and

Item I Give my negro woman named Judy to my son George Jordan
after the Death of my wife — — —

Item 3 my will is that after the Death of my wife my Daughter
Ann misnerick have four cows and calves — — —

Item my will is that my wife do what sh^e Pleaseth with
what moveable Estate she hath in Possession at
her Death except what Legacye I have mentioned
in this my will and I do appoint my Loving
wife Sarah Jordan and my son George Jordan to
be my Executors to this my Last Will and Testament
and do hereby Revoke all other Wills by me made
