from and my bebedock - my corn field - and John Popes
I give and bequeath unto my brother David - Son Matthew Roberson
my old plantation and all the Land I hold on the Long Side
of the mill - &c &c &c I give and bequeath unto my Brother
Matthew - Son George Roberson my mill and plantation and
Land &c &c I am now Living on in Granville County
I give and bequeath unto my brother Nicholas - Son Charles Roberson
half the Cattle I have and my brother Charles - Son Julius Roberson
the other - half I give and bequeath unto my Sister
Susannah Heindrich my Gray horse I give and bequeath unto my
brother Joseph - Son Joel Roberson one feather bed - & my
bills & pack - Daughter Sarah Roberson one feather bed
I leave my Brother Matthew Roberson
and James Heindrich Executors of my will
