being weak of Body but of Perfect mind and memory Thanks be unto
Mighty God for the same and I do appoint this my last will and
Testament being it is appointed for all unto Die I give and bequeath
my Soul into the hands of God that gave it me hoping to Receive the
same at the generall Resurrection and my Body to be buried in a Decent
Christian manner at the Discretion of my Executors

I am my will is that all my just Debts be paid and funeral expences
I must give and bequeath unto my well beloved Son James Hunt one
Negro boy Named Cato to him and his heirs for ever also I give to my said
Son James Hunt the smallest of my lands and that my said Son James
Hunt have the above Named Negro when he shall arrive to the age of
Twenty one years also I give a certain Parcel or tract of Land to my said
James Hunt beginning at the Branch above the Plantation whereon I now
Dwell and running South West

I must give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Hunt one Negro
girl Named Lydia and all hereunto appertaining for ever and that
my said Daughter Elizabeth Hunt have the said Negro girl at the time of her
age of Twenty years

I must give and bequeath unto my well beloved Son Henry Hunt one Negro
boy Named Nero to him and his heirs for ever

I must give and bequeath unto my well beloved Son William Hunt one Negro
girl Named Pat and all hereunto appertaining to him and his heirs for ever

I must give and bequeath unto my well beloved Son George Hunt that while
that my Negro woman Fanny is now with Child of whether it prove boy or girl
I must give and bequeath unto my said Son George Hunt

and give and bequeath unto my well beloved son William Hunt once Negro
boy named Nero to him and his heirs for ever
I Hunt give and bequeath unto my well beloved son William Hunt once Negro
girl named Patti and all her increase to him and his heirs for ever
I Hunt give and bequeath unto my well beloved son George Hunt that child
that my Negro woman Jenny is now with Child of C. If it prove boy or girl
to him and his heirs for ever
I Hunt give and bequeath unto my well beloved son John Hunt once Negro
woman named Jenny and all her increase (excepting the Child as before mention
ed that I gave to my son George Hunt all the rest of her increase to him and
his heirs for ever
I Hunt give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife Agnes Hunt all my
Personal Estate of Moveables both within and without and all and every
Part and parcel thereof unto her the said Agnes Hunt and to be at her Disposal
as she shall see fit to Dispose of the same and also that she the said Agnes Hunt
live and abide on the Plantation whereon I now dwell During her Life and that
she have the use of all the Negroes During the time that she continues a widow
except them two Negroes that I give to my son and Daughters James and Elizabeth
Hunt and after the Decease of my Beloved wife Agnes Hunt I give and bequeath
unto my son George Hunt the Plantation whereon I now dwell with all Houfes
and out Houfes to him and his heirs for ever and this I Do Nominate and
Ordain that she my beloved wife be my Executor and my Beloved son
James Hunt Executor and this I Do ordain to be my Last Will and testament
Defeating and revoking all former wills and testaments for others or
Legacies ever before made this only to be and remain my Last Will
and testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this the Thirteenth Day of November One Thousand Seven Hundred & fifty
