in my will & what Brandy I have

 two heirs heirs & assigns for ever

Four head of Cattle & a Sow & Pig & One Feather Bed & Furniture
I Leave to be Divided Between my Son George & my Son John & all
my Hay Tools One Hundred Bushels of Corn more or less ^{Seven bushels} beginning upon Morgans
his running on last course to a branch & all up of South Part of of Ireland I Give to him
his heirs heirs & assigns for ever

I Give & Bequeath to my well Beloved Son John Winston Four head
of Cattle & all of Remander of my Stock of hogs After my Wife has Taken
A Thousand Weight as I Mentioned Above & all my Carpenters Tools
& some Household Goods as I Put at Conellie Vandue & after the Decease of my Wife I Give
the Manner Plantation of Cheshire I Give Containing in of Last One Hundred & twenty
Eight Acres as was Mentioned Above & of L. Land I Give to him his heirs &
Assigns for ever.

I Give to my well Beloved Daughter Mary Winston One Feather Bed One Young
Grey Horse One to him & of Remander Part of my Cattle that is Over & Above What I have
already Mentioned above

I Give to my well Beloved Son Anthony Winston Two Shillings Virg.ⁿ Money

I Give & Bequeath to my well Beloved Son Will^m Winston Two Shillings Virg.ⁿ Money

I Give & Bequeath to my well Beloved Son in Law Will^m Davis Two Shillings Virg.ⁿ Money

And I do Make Void all other Wills holding holding this
