Land. And Also my Plantation whereon I now live on Lying
On Both Sides of mill Creek Containing two hundred &
Acres of Land, that I bought of Andrew Hampton lying
in Granvill County & Province of North Carolina and
Also all my household goods & all my Cattle & ~~the~~
Horses and hogs, which Land Cattle & horses & hogs I
freely give to my wife Ann to do as she thinks most
it shall be ever Also it is my will & Desire that

my soul wishes that a friend of god that gave it me & my duty
to be Buried in a Decent manner, Then I give and
Bequeath unto my son Isaac Shipp my Plantation
