Whole of my other Estate be it what Nature
or quality so ever after my death to be paid
Moreover I do Appoint my two friends Capt
John Pope and William Hunt peaceable
and sole Executors of this my last Will
utterly Disanuling and making void all
former Wills and Testaments by me made
In Witness of what is Above mentioned
hereunto set my hand and Seal This
thirteenth first Day of march 1770
