ing what ovedy Estate if hath pleased god to bless
me with in this life I give Devise and Dispose in
Manner and forms following

Item I give and bequeath to my son John Wright
ten pound virginia money

Item I give and bequeath to Zachariah Wright son
of John Wright one hundred and eighty acres
of Land lying on Enocks Creek in granvil County

Item I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Wright ten
pound virginia money and one bay colt and one
chift

Item I give and bequeath to

one and with in this life I give Devise and Dispose in
Manner and form as following Viz
I give and bequeath to my son John Wright
ten pound virginia money

I give and bequeath to Zachariah Wright son
of John Wright one hundred and eighty acres
of Land lying on Crooked Creek in Granvil County

I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Wright ten
pound virginia money and one bay colt and one
chiff

I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Wright
ten pound virginia money and one hundred and
eighty acres of Land lying on Crooked Creek in Granvil
County and one gray horse called Bird and all my hogs and any other
tools

I give and bequeath to my son William Wright ten
pound virginia money and one hundred and eighty acres
of Land lying on Crooked Creek in Granvil County and
one black chain and all my remaining clothes

I give and bequeath to Jephtha Wright son of Lidia
Wright one hundred and seven acres of Land lying on
Crooked Creek in Granvil County Concluding the plantation
that the said Joseph Wright is possess with at this
present

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter and daughter
Hunnysent ten pound virginia money

Item I give and bequeath after my lawfull debts
and paid the Remainder of money house hold
goods hogs cattle and one chair to be Equally
Divided between my Daughter Lidia wright
and my Daughter Elizabeth wright

I like wife of Consistute make and ordain
my beloved son Joseph wright and John
Hunnysent to be my sole and only Executors
of this my Last will and Testament Disanuling
and Revoaking all other former writings wills
or Testaments before this time made and
Ratified this and no other to be my last
will and Testament in witness hereof
I have hereunto set my hand and Effixed
my seal the Day and year first above
written
