Assigns forever together with the stock & household
furniture now in his possession. Item I give & bequeath
unto Samuel Fuller the Tract of land where he now
lives Containing six hundred & forty acres together
with the stock & furniture now in his possession. Item
I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Spivey
Two hundred Acres of land now in the possession of
William Lawrence to her her heirs or assigns forever
together with one mare two cows & calves one bed and
furniture and two sows & pigs. Item I do nominate &

and Testament.

lives containing six hundred & forty acres together
with the stock & furniture now in his possession Item.
I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth the Spicer
Two hundred acres of land now in the possession of
William Lawrence to her her heirs or assigns forever
together with one mare two cows & calves one bed and
furniture and two sows & pigs Item. I do nominate &
appoint my loving wife Anna Spicer and my son in
law Henry Fuller my Executors of this my last will
and Testament ratifying and confirming this and no
Other to be my last will and testament In witness
