Item I give and bequeath unto my Well beloved son Richard White and his  
heirs and assigns forever, all and singular other and the rest of  
my Estate both Personal and Real of all kinds Whatsoever, that now  
is in my possession or shall hereafter become mine forever, besides  
my funeral Expence, By him & freely to be possessed and Enjoyed  
as also hereby Nominating and Appointing my said son Richard  
White my Whole & sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament.
