I Robert Mitchell of Granvell County, in North Carolina, being sick & Weak in body, but of a perfect mind and disposing Memory, I thank be given to almighty god for the same, therefore Calling to mind the Uncertain Estate of This Life, and that it is appointed — — — to Die — — — Testament, that is to say principally, and first of all I Recommend my Soul into the hands of god that Gave it and my body to be buried in Decent Christian burial at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter by me mentioned, Nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall Receive the same again by the mighty power of god, and as Touching such Worldly Estate, wherewith it hath pleased god to bestow on me in this Life, I Give and Dispose of the same in manner and form following, that is to say, first of all — — will that all those Debts and Legacies — — Right or — — — be forthwith levied out of my Estate and paid. — — —

I Tem. I Give and bequeath to my well beloved Wife Catherine Mitchell one Negro man Named Sambor also one Negro Wench Named Lindar and after the said Catherine's Decease, the said Lindar Return to my Well beloved Son

Given to almighty god for the Same, therefore  
Calling to mind the Uncertain Estate of This  
Life, and that it is appointed — — — to Die  
— — — Testament, that is to say principally,  
and first of all I Recommend my soul into the  
hands of god that Gave it and my body to be  
buried in Decent Christian burial at the

Resurrection I Shall Receive the Same again

Ever, I Likewise Give and bequeath to my  
well beloved Wife all my household goods,  
as bedding & furniture and pots and pans and  
all my moveable household Effects to be Dis-

posed of at her Discretion -

I Tem. I Give and bequeath to my well Beloved son Daniel Mitchell one Negro Wench Named Sary also one piece of Land Lying & being in Lunenburg County in Virginia Lying Opposite my old plantation on the River of which piece of Land I have delivered the s<sup>d</sup>. Daniel a Patent of 286 Acres also another piece of Land Lying on both sides of Island Creek in the said County Containing one hundred and thirty five Acres for which I have also delivered him a patent for the same to him his heirs and assigns for Ever - - - - -

I Tem. I Give and bequeath to my Well beloved son Robert Mitchell one Negro boy Named Peter also one piece of Land Lying on the South Side of Roanoke River in Lunenburg County, Containing four hundred and ninety Acres for him his heirs and assigns for Ever

I Tem. I give and bequeath to my well beloved son Isaac Mitchell one Negro boy Named George also one piece of Land being in Granville County in North Carolina Lying on Both Sides of Island Creek Containing better then Six hundred Acres to him his heirs and assigns for Ever

being in Lunenburg County in Virginia lying  
Opposite my old plantation on the River of  
Which piece of Land I have delivered the said  
Daniel a Patent of 286 Acres also another  
piece of Land lying on both sides of Island  
Creek in the said County containing one hundred  
and thirty five Acres for which I have also  
delivered him a patent for the same to him  
his heirs and assigns for Ever - - - - -

Item. I Give and bequeath to my Well be-  
loved Son Robert Mitchell one Negro boy named  
Peter also one piece of Land lying on the  
South Side of Roanoke River in Lunenburg  
County, containing four hundred and ninety Acres  
for him his heirs and assigns for Ever

I Tem. I give and bequeath to my well beloved  
son Isaac Mitchell one Negro boy named George  
also one piece of Land being in Granwell County in  
North Carolina lying on Both sides of Island  
Creek containing better then six hundred  
Acres. to him his heirs and assigns for Ever

I Tem. also Give and bequeath to my well  
beloved Son John Mitchell one piece of Land  
lying and being in Granwell County on both  
sides of Island Creek containing three hundred  
and fifty Acres to him his heirs and assigns

for Ever

I Tem. I Give and bequeath to my Well beloved Daughter Sussannah Glover one Negro Wench Named Betty, to her and the Lawfull begotten heirs of her body for Ever

I Tem. I Give and Bequeath to my well Beloved Daughter Phebe Glover one Negro boy Named Dick to her and the Lawfull begotten heirs of her body for Ever

I Tem. I Give and Bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Mary Mitchell one Negro boy Named Singgoe to her and the Lawfull begotten heirs of her body for Ever

I Tem. I Give and bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Martha Mitchell one Negro boy Named Roger to her and the Lawfull begotten heirs of her body for Ever

I Tem. I will also that all my Stock of horses Cattle, Hogs, & Sheep and all the Moveable Effects of Stock be Equally Divided to my Wife and Children and the same to be Distributed to Every one Equally, by my well beloved Friends Jacob Mitchell and Isaac Mitchell of Lunenburg County Whom I also appoint to be my sole

heirs of her body for ever

I Tem. I Give and Bequeath to my well Beloved Daughter Phoebe Glover one Negro boy Named Dick to her and the Lawfull begotten heirs of her body for Ever

I Tem. I Give and Bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Mary Mitchell one Negro boy Named Singoe to her and the Lawfull begotten heirs of her body for Ever

I Tem. I Give and bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Martha Mitchell one Negro boy Named Roger to her and the Lawfull begotten heirs of her body for Ever

I Tem. I will also that all my Stock of horses Cattle. Hogs. & Sheep and all the Moveable Effects of Stock be Equally Divided to my Wife and Children and the same to be Distributed to Every one Equally, by my well beloved Friends, Jacob Mitchell and Isaac Mitchell of Lunenburg County Whom I also Appoint to be my Sole & Sole Executors of this my Last will & Testament in Witness Whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal the Day and year Above Written
