all I give and recommend my soul in to the hands

recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent  
Christian burial at the discretion of my executors  
nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection  
I shall receive the same again by the mighty  
power of God and at present such worldly Estate  
where with it has pleased God to bless me in this  
life I give devise and dispose of the same in the  
following manner and form

first I give and bequeath to my well beloved

son Arthur Jordan a bed and four uture like  
vis four barrels of Corn and four young hogs  
likewise two carlings a bole and a cow

also give to my well beloved son of George

Jordan a bed and furniter

also I give to my well beloved Daughter Elizabeth Gilliam  
the Case of bottles and binning wheat and horse and  
Saddle and four barrels of Corn and four young  
hogs

also give to my well beloved Daughter Anne  
Merrick two young Cattle

also I give to my grand Daughter Patsey Gibbons  
a bed and furniture and four water basins and twelve  
plates a pot and a pair

and I bear my son George Tordens sole Exec't  
of this my last Will and Testament.

all things left out of this will I leave to my  
son George Torden who is to receive all debts  
and likewise pay all debts as shall come against the  
Estate signed sealed and delivered in presence of my

test
