all Sumas of money due from him to me &c

Item I Give and bequeath to my loving Daughter Sarah Harris
the same being the same

Jonathan White to my dear son Henry White
Henry White formerly lived to him and his heirs and
a piece for ever

~~one hundred and fifty acres of land to my daughter Mary Harris~~
of Jonathan White's estate her husband's estate
now devolve to her and her heirs and a piece for ever
I then I give and bequeath to my loving son in law Absolom Harris
all sum of money due from him to me &c

I then I give and bequeath to my loving daughter Sarah Harris
one bay mare known by the name of Peaby

I then I give and bequeath unto my son Sherwood Harris one black
natural pacing mare and my bridle and saddle

five shillings sterling money of England
