negro fellow named Jacob an one negro boy ^{named} Dick
and I do also Leave to my wife an my son Roger
one hundred pounds Virginia money for to purchase
two more negroes —

one hundred pounds Virginia money for to purchase
two negroes more for her use her widowhood an then
one of them I give to my ^{son} Thomas an the other to my
son Roger ~

hold goods and stock of every thing that I possess

for the maintainance of my family During her
widowhood but if she doth marry then for it
to be Equily Devided betwix my four Children
and I have here appointed my wife an Son
Roger to be Executor of my holk and Sole Estate
of this my last will and testament as witness my
hand the twelf day of february in the year of our
lord one thousand seven hundred an Sixty one
