Item first: I give and devise to my husband James M. Aswell my tract of land on which we now live lying in Shire Township Greene County N.C. adjoining the lands of Taylor Barrow and the Best land beginning at a pine Best's corner formerly called the Silver Turner corner and run with Best's line with a path N. 4° E 94 poles then with another path and Best's other line N. 69° 1/2 W. 200 1/2 poles to a stake then down a bottom its various courses to a stake Taylor Barrow's corner then with his line S. 1° E 45 poles to a stake on a ditch then up the various courses of the ditch about N. 88 1/2 E. 2 poles and 16 links S. 88 1/2 E 8 poles S. 79 1/2 E 9 poles N. 79 1/2 E. 13 poles N. 85 1/2 E 10 poles S. 83 1/2 E 13 poles N. 33 1/2 E. 4 poles N. 50. E. 6 1/2 poles N. 65 1/2 E 11 poles N. 34 1/2 E 11 1/2 poles to a stake then S. 86 1/2 E. 37 poles and 8 links to a red oak on the side of the path then with the path S. 11 1/2 W. 07 poles and 20 links to a stake then S. 7 1/2 E 100 1/2 poles to Best's line then with his line N. 80 1/2 E. 115 1/2 poles to the beginning containing one hundred and twenty three acres. To have and to hold to him if I should leave no child or children, to his use and behoof in fee simple title, forever and lastly I nominate and appoint my trusty friend James D.
