2nd I give and devise to my beloved wife Mary Ormond all my lands (Real estate of all kinds) during her natural life or widowhood and if she should remarry at any time I desire it shall be divided equally between my children

3rd - I give and devise to my said wife Mary Ormond one Policy of Two Thousand dollars said policy being in the Security Life and Annuity Company hereinafter named and desire that she shall use the same as she may deem best during her widowhood and give whatever she may deem right to any of my children after their death just thereto

4th I give and devise to my beloved wife Mary Ormond all my stock of all kind crops on hand or growing all provisions, all household and kitchen furniture of all kind all moneys on hand, and all my personal property of every description, then to give it or any part of it to any one or more of my children as she may deem right and just and desire that she divide every thing as near just and equal between my children as she well can.

5th I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Mary Ormond my lawful executrix to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and testament

according to the true intent and meaning thereof and every part thereof hereby resolving all other wills by me heretofore made I in witness whereof I the said E. C. Ormond do hereunto set my hand and seal this the 1st day of November 1905-

I, J. E. W. Sugg of Greene County, State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death do make and declare this my last will and testament in form and form following:

That is to say

I That my executing hereafter named shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the rank of my relations & friends, and pay all funeral expenses together with all my just debts - however and whenever they come out of the first moneys that may come into her hands as a part of my estate

II All down & enjoy in the way of real and personal property is now called my wife as it is mine I therefore will and devise unto her the use and absolute control of all my real and personal property during her widowhood living and breathing she will never marry again but of the household many again I will and devise that before as doing that she shall relinquish all her right title and interest to and heretofore granted her in all my real and personal property and that the same shall be equally divided among all my children or their heirs as hereafter provided.

III After the death of my wife or ^{real and} surviving she will do, I will and devise that all my personal property be equally divided among all my children, or their heirs by administration chosen, one member of said Committee be each child of fifteen years and upwards of age and I hereby appoint my oldest child at that time to choose the members of the committee for the youngest child, my next oldest for the next in age above the youngest and so on, until each child is represented upon that Committee and if said Committee shall be not agreed as to the said equal division of my property then I direct that the said Committee shall be called upon by the Court to be at that time of said Committee representing me and is to be equally interested in each of my children
