 following. That is to say: First that my Executors

 soever owing together with my burial and funeral  
 expenses out of the monies that may first come  
 into their hands as a part and parcel of my estate.  
 Item I give and bequeath to the trustees of the Baptist  
 Memorial Church in the town of Greenville of  
 the County and State aforesaid the sum of fifty  
 dollars. Item I give and bequeath the sum of  
 one hundred dollars for the purpose of aiding to  
 enclose with a stone fence the Brown family  
 grave yard situated on the Henry W Brown  
 place which is a Brown now lives. Item.  
 I give and bequeath to my nephew Benj J. Wilson  
 all the notes and accounts I hold against him  
 date previous to May the 7<sup>th</sup> 1897 one hundred dollars  
 in cash. My iron fire proof safe and the tools  
 and profits arising from my farm in Greene  
 County, Edmundville Township State of North Caro-  
 lina known as the Brown place for the year last  
 of my earthly existence also give and bequeath  
 to the said B. J. Wilson the note and mortgage I  
 hold against James H. Rives and my Father  
 Dick. Item I give and bequeath to the children  
 of my niece Susan C. Johnson deceased and to  
 the children of my niece Sarah A. Grimsley,  
 deceased all the notes and accounts I hold  
 against them respectively dated prior to May 1<sup>st</sup>  
 1897. Item I give and bequeath to my great nephew  
 Dr. F. W. Brown all the notes and accounts I hold  
 against H. H. Wilson him date previous to  
 April 1<sup>st</sup> 1898 in payment of his professional  
 services rendered on any account and to be his  
 equitable portion of my estate. Item I give and  
 bequeath to my great nephew Jessie W. Brown  
 my marble top center Table, one big Beding set

Table, Big Cane back Rocking chair. Item I give and  
 bequeath to my great niece Susan C. Wilson my  
 Piano and also all the notes and accounts I hold  
 against H. H. Wilson date prior to May 1<sup>st</sup> 1898.  
 Item I give and bequeath to my great niece Mr  
 Adalide Johnson my Beemer Item I give and  
 bequeath to my great niece Willie Myers Grimsley my  
 tract of land situated in Spight Bridge Township  
 Greene County, State of North Carolina known as the  
 Jumping Run place, deeded to me by J. M. Patrick Trustee  
 Dec 3<sup>rd</sup> 1896. Item I give and bequeath to my great  
 nephew Jessie W. Brown all the notes and mortgages I hold  
 against him his lifetime and then to his two  
 children Madeline and Wilbur. and I hereby direct  
 my executors to have said mortgage foreclosed and  
 executed the deed as above in time of the necessary  
 money for the purchase from the said Jessie W. Brown.  
 Item I give and bequeath to my great nephew William  
 W. Brown all the notes I hold against him. Item  
 My Will and desire is that all the residue of my estate  
 of whatever nature or kind sover or whomever the  
 same shall be at the time of my death, not heretofore  
 mentioned, shall be divided into two equal shares  
 I give, bequeath and direct to my nephew Benj J. Wilson  
 one share I give, bequeath and direct the other share  
 as follows viz one third to the children of my niece  
 Susan C. Johnson, deceased, one third to the chil-  
 dren of my niece Sarah A. Grimsley deceased, and  
 the remaining one third to be equally divided between  
 my great nieces Lizzie T. Edwards, and Jessie B. Wilson  
 and the children of my great nephew F. W. Brown.  
 Item I give and bequeath to my great niece Annie  
 N. Grimsley my new home Sewing Machine. Lastly  
 I hereby constitute and appoint my nephew Benj J.  
 Wilson and my great nephew William W. Brown  
 my lawful executors without bond, to all intents  
 and purposes to execute this my last Will and  
 Testament according to the true intent and mean-
