Eighthly And as to my son Henry I hereby Give &
Bequeath a tract or parcel of land wherein he now

fifteen degrees West to John Stus line containing some what more
than Two Hundred Acres to have & hold to him & his heirs forever
I also will that he said Henry have fifty Dollars to be collected
out of my money that is outstanding & that he his wife & heirs
jointly I will & bequeath unto my son Abner my Old plantation
& all the lands thereunto belonging to wit all the lands lying & being

hereof, Also one Horse creature no less Value than
sixty five Dollars. Also as much Bedding & house
hold furniture as any one of her Sisters had

Out of my money that is outstanding & that he his last of kind
kindly I will bequeath unto my son Abner my old plantation
& all the lands thereunto belonging to wit all the lands lying & being
on the North side of the aforesaid Course Vg. from the Cogwood
South fifteen degrees West to John Stur line to him & his heirs

& sisters beginning at the oldest & pay fifty Dollars yearly
until paid I also will that a negro girl named Luce be
remain with her old mistress my widow during the life
time of her old mistress then to be sold & the other offspring
of any, & the money equally to be divided amongst all
my children. I also will that after my Decease
my widow shall have full privilege in the mansion
House & other Houses & premises without molestation.
Kindly unto my youngest Daughter Barbary I Give & bequeath
a yellow Negro girl named Nelly to her & her heirs, also two
Hundred Dollars to be collected out of my money that
is outstanding. With the Interest thereof from the date
hereof, Also one Horse creature no less Value than
Sixty five Dollars. Also as much Bedding & house
hold furniture as any one of her sisters had
When they left me
And I do hereby constitute make & ordain my
