also all my Stock of Horse Cattle Sheep & Hogs together with
all my household furniture and lots of any kind whatever
Belonging to the said plantation and I do hereby offer and declare
this and no other to be my Last Will & Testament in thing being
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this the 11th day
of February in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Ninety two.
