1st I Give & bequeath to my wife Kelly Johnson One third part of the plantation whereon I now live during her natural life & for her to dispose of the same as she may think proper & all my house hold & kitchen furniture, One Horse & colts & One Cow four Sheep, One Sow & pigs

2nd I Give & bequeath to my son James Johnson the balance of the plantation ~~whereon I now live~~ whereon I now live One Horse & colts, One Rifle Gun & all my wearing clothes & all my farming tools.

3rd I Give & bequeath to my daughters Abigail Caty & Kelly One piece of land known by the name of Hickman's place to be divided equally among them agreeable to Quantity & Valuations.

4th The balance of my stock to be sold & the money arising therefrom to be applied, first to a decent burial of my body, second to the discharge of my debts & if there should be any surplus money it is to be divided equally among my wife & Children.

And I do hereby Appoint my brother William Johnson & my son James Johnson my Executors to this my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this Seventeenth of October Eighteen Hundred & Sixteen.
