and State of North Carolina, being in ordinary health and mind, thanks be to God
by the same, do this twentieth day of November A.D. 1853 make and ordain this my last
Will and Testament, and as touching such worldly estate as it has pleased God to bless
me with in this life, I give and devise and dispose of as herein after mentioned.
I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Mary the Tract of Land on which I now re-
side, my negro man Luke, my negro woman Sarah, my Negro girl Eliza and my
negro child Beethoven and all the increase of them should be any of the above men-
tioned and all my stock of horses that I may own and possess at the time of
my decease, and one saddle and two bridles, one Wagon and gear, and all of
my farming tools of every description whatever, and also the whole of my stock
of hogs and cattle sheep and geese, all my household and kitchen furniture
of every description during her natural life, and at her decease the Tract of
Land aforesaid to be equally divided between my two daughters, Minerva
Daughterly and Malinda Trust and the balance of the property left to my
aforesaid Wife if there should be any at her decease to be equally divided
among my three children, Minerva Daughterly, Malinda Trust and Andrew
Sonsus Black, and I also Will and ordain that my said Wife at her
own discretion sell and dispose of any of the Stock that she may so possess

2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter. Rebecca Naughton my Negro girl
Phelia and my negro Girl Martha to be possessed forever.

3rd I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter. Malinda Teast my Negro girl Dolly
to be possessed forever.

4th I give and bequeath to my beloved son. Andrew Sanders Black a tract of Land
in the aforesaid County of Guilford on the Water of Waugia. Conveyed to me by
Sarah Webb late Widow of Thomas Webb Decd. together with all the appurtenances
to the said Tract of Land belonging or in any way pertaining to the same, upon
me being to a Deed of Conveyance from the above named Sarah Webb to me
for the proper boundaries of the said Land to have and to hold to my said
son Andrew Sanders Black, his heirs and offspring forever; I also give and
bequeath to said son my Negro girl Dolly and my Negro boy Alfred by him
truly to be possessed forever and also one set of Smith tools and all that per-
tains to my Shop

5th I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Fervina Samtoll in addition
to what I have already given her the sum of one dollar and also to my be-
loved son Olesha Black the sum of one dollar, and to the heirs of my
