being perfect in mind & memory, but calling to mind the mortality  
of my body, & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die.

I do make & Ordain this my last will & Testament in manner aforesaid  
as follows. Painesville & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the  
hands of Almighty God, Who gave it & my body to the earth to be buried in  
a decent manner at the direction of my Executor, not doubting but at the  
General Resurrection I shall receive the same by the Almighty power  
of God. And as touching such worldly estate as it has pleased God to bless  
me with in this life, I give devise & bequeath in the following manner  
viz. 1<sup>st</sup> I will & devise unto Jane Gibson my dear & beloved wife, six  
Negroes Namely John, Bell, Lucy, Jacob, David & Moriah Two Beds  
& Bedchairs, Two Horses, Two Cows, One half of a Pleasure carriage,  
one half of the Crop upon Hand & Growing & one half of all the  
Provisions of every description on said plantation also the main  
body of my dwelling house during her natural life or widowhood.

It is my Will that she after her decease shall work in the Crop, on the  
plantation or in the house along with the hands of my son Joseph  
& he the said Joseph to maintain his Mother, and furnish her  
with every thing necessary another tract of Recessions or Clothings  
that will render her here comfortable.

2<sup>nd</sup> I will & devise unto James Gibson the Tract of Land wherein  
he now contains Three Hundred Acres & the two Negroes there  
fore giving him Mary & Parke & there increased lineal issue  
Also all the property hitherto given him.

3<sup>rd</sup> I will & devise unto John T Gibson the Tract of Land wherein  
he has Built & improved containing One hundred & Eighty  
Acres also all the land in the Bent of Back Creek Called  
the Indian Field in Orange County, Supposed to be Thirty  
Acre Two Negroes Matilda & Dick his Mare Taney which  
is already given also One Bed & furniture & Rugs to be given  
Also all the Cattle & other property heretofore given Also  
Three Hundred & fifty Dollars in Cash to be paid when my  
Money is collected & if there should not be enough the remainder  
is to be paid after the death of his Mother.

4<sup>th</sup> I will & devise unto Moses Gibson the Tract of Land

of my body, & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die.  
I do make & Ordain this my last will & declaration in manner aforesaid  
as follows. Principall & first of all I give & recommend my soul unto the  
hands of Almighty God, Who gave it & my body to the earth to be buried in  
a decent manner at the discretion of my Executor, not doubting but at the  
general Resurrection shall receive the same by the Almighty power  
of God. And as touching such worldly estate as it has pleased God to bless  
me with in this life, I give same & dispose of in the following manner

viz. 1<sup>st</sup> I will & devise unto Jane Gibson my dear & beloved wife, six  
Negroes Of woman John, Bett, Lucy, Jacob, David & Micah Two Beds  
& Furniture. Two Horses, Two Cows, One half of a Pleasure carriage,  
one half of the Crop upon hand growing & one half of all the  
Provisions of every description on said plantation also the main  
body of my dwelling house during her natural life or widowhood.

It is my Will that she after my decease shall work in the Crop, on the  
plantation or in the house along with the hands of my son Joseph  
& he the said Joseph to maintain his Mother and furnish her  
with any thing necessary another tract of Ground or Cloathing  
that will render her the comfortable

2<sup>nd</sup> I will & devise unto James Gibson the Tract of Land wherein  
he lies containing Thre Hundred Acres & the two Negroes thereto  
fore given him Mary & Darby & there increased since given  
Also all the Property heretofore given him

3<sup>rd</sup> I will & devise unto John T Gibson the Tract of Land wherein  
he has Built & improved Containinge One hundred & Eighty  
Acres Also all the Land in the Bint of Back Creek Called  
the Indian Field in Orange County. Supposed to be Thirty  
Acre Two Negroes Matthy & Dick his Mare Tancy which  
is already given also One Bed of furniture & Rugs to be given  
Also all the Cattle & other Property heretofore given Also  
Thre Hundred & fifty Dollars in Cash to be paid when my  
Money is Collected & if there should not be enough the remainder  
is to be paid After the death of his Mother.

4<sup>th</sup> I will & devise unto Moses Gibson the Tract or Parcels  
of Land he lies on Supposed to containe Thre hundred  
& fifty Acres to begin at the Rocke Ledge corner.

& then with<sup>ing</sup> to the Blacke Sack then E. with running to the corner of  
line then with a Drain & marked line to Wilson's North East corner  
& again to his North West corner then to New line & with him to  
the Housto Road & up the line of his brother Joseph & with his  
line to the beginning Also Two Negroes Paddy & Bill 4 Cm Cows  
get to be given with all the Property heretofore given

5<sup>th</sup> I Will & devise unto Joseph Gibson the Tract of land on which  
I live (Leaving a life Estate, or Maintenance for his Mother) Also  
the Trade & course of my dwelling House Two Negroes Henry & Lige  
Also One good Horse Creatures & Two Cows, get to be given & One  
half of the crop now on hand or growing & one half of all  
the Provisions of every description on said Plantation also the  
Farming Tools & Plantation instruments & Cars of all kinds  
It is my Will that if my Son Joseph die before his Wife  
Marianna, that she shall have the same Right Priviledge and  
Maintenance as she now has so long as she remains his.

6<sup>th</sup> I Will & devise unto Joseph Gibson his Exct<sup>r</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> or Assigning  
in Trust to hold to the use of the Heirs of Elizabeth Gibson body  
(but she to have a Maintenance during her life) a certain  
Tract or parcel of land lying in the Counties of Guilford & Orange  
Virginia ab or near the County line ab Hillsboro Road then  
up Said Road to the first branch down the same to Back  
Creek then down it to where it intersects with Summers line  
all the Land East of this boundary Also Two Negroes Hannah  
and Ayers & their increase Also One horse, Drawers, Two Beds  
and Furniture, Cattle, & Horse Furniture all of which I have  
heretofore loaned her the said Elizabeth

7<sup>th</sup> I Will & devise unto Joseph Gibson his Exct<sup>r</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> or Assigning  
in Trust to hold to the use & benefit of the Heir of Jane Gibson body  
(but she to have a Maintenance during her life) One half of a tract  
of Land known by the Name of Thompson Tract to be equally divided  
as to Quantity & Quality by my Executor Also Two Negroes Amos and  
Sally & their increase One Horse Saddle & Bridle Two Cows & Calves  
Two Beds of furniture One Cupboard One Chest One Table  
With all the other Property heretofore loaned

8<sup>th</sup> I Will & devise unto Joseph Gibson his Exct<sup>r</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> or Assigning  
in Trust to hold to the use of the Heir of Nancy Gibsons body

Again to his North West corner then to the  
the Northwest road & up the line of his Brother Joseph & Will  
line to the Beginning Also Two Negroes Paddy & Bill & One Cow  
Cat to be Given with all the Property heretofore Given  
5<sup>th</sup> I Will & devise Unto Joseph Gibson the Tract of Land on Which  
I live & surviving a life Estate, or Maintenance for his Mother also  
the Trade Roome of my dwelling House Two Negroes Also & wife  
Also One Good Horse Creatures & Two Cows, Cat to be Given & One  
Half of the Crop Now on Hand or Growing & One half of all  
the Provisions of Every description on said Plantation also the  
Farming Tools & Plantation instruments & Cars of all kinds.  
It is my Will that of my Son Joseph die before his Wife  
Marianne that she shall have the same Right & privilege and  
Maintenance as she now has so long as she remains his.

6<sup>th</sup> I Will & devise Unto Joseph Gibson his Factor Adm't or assign  
in Trust to hold to the Use of the Heirs of Elizabeth Gibson body  
(but she to have a Maintenance during her life) a certain  
Tract or parcel of land lying in the Counties of Guilford & Orange  
beginning at or near the County line at Stellboro' Load then  
Up Said Road to the first branch above the same to Back  
Creek then down it to where it intersects with Summers line  
all the land East of this boundary Also Two Negroes Mannah  
and Agnes & their increase Also One horse, Drawers, Two Beds  
and Furniture, Cattes, & Horse furniture all of which I have  
heretofore loaned to the said Elizabeth  
7<sup>th</sup> I Will & devise Unto Joseph Gibson his Factor Adm't or assign  
in Trust to hold to the use & benefit of the Heirs of Jane Gibson body  
(but she to have a Maintenance during her life) One half of a Tract  
of Land known by the Name of Thompson Tract to be equally divided  
as to Quantity & Quality by my Executors Also Two Negroes  
Sallie & their increase One Horse Saddle & Bridle Two Cows & Calves  
Two Beds of furniture One Buff board one Chest One Table  
With all the Other Property heretofore loaned  
8<sup>th</sup> I Will & devise Unto Joseph Gibson his Factor Adm't or assign  
in Trust to hold to the use of the Heirs of Nancy Gibbons

the Other half of said Thompson Tract to be divided as  
aforesaid & two Year Negro Well Rubin Rachael &  
Amey & their increase, One Horse Creature, the Choice of  
Six Chickens Two Cows & Calves Two beds & furniture, One Set  
of Drawers One Saddle & Bridle & as much Other Property.  
I av. Will make her Miss Part equal to that of her sisters.

When they left me -

I Will & desire that if any of my Children Should  
Die without issue begotten in合法 stocke, that there Property  
Return to be equally divided among all my Children  
the said Joseph Trustee holding such Part in Trust that  
may or shall Come to my daughters to their Children.


I Will & desire that after the death of my Widow that the  
Property I have given her together with all the rest of my Estate  
both Real & Personal Lands in this State of South Carolina  
Georgia & Florida Also Bonds Notes & Cash Be equally  
divided among all my Children the Part which my Daughters  
Shall be entitell to goe to in Trust to my Son Joseph  
his Mrs Edr. Adm<sup>r</sup> & his wife to hold to the use of the Heirs  
of my Daughters aforesaid (but they to have a Maintenance  
during their lives - It is my desire that the Property Shall  
be divided Without selling it if it can be done).

And I hereby Constitute & Appoint James Gibson & Joseph  
Gibson Executors of this my last Will & Testament, revoking every  
Other former Will by me made allowing this & no other to be  
my last Will & Testament,
